Our fundraisers to date are: Police Memorial Campaign, Paws 4 a Cause, "Fit For Life" 5K Run/Walk and Dancing with the Whittier Stars.

The Whittier Community Foundation "Fit For Life" Spooktacular 5K Run/Walk and Creepy Crawly 1/2 mile dash (12 and under) promotes fitness for all ages on a USATF CERTIFIED COURSE. The event is held at the end of October and draws over 800 people to the community.



The "Paws 4 a Cause" Canine 3K Walk/Run and Fashion Show is an event that includes a Dog 3K Walk/Run, a "Mini-Mutt" shorter run for smaller and/or older dogs, a Dog Fashion Show, demonstrations from Police K9 groups, search and rescue groups, pet therapy groups and more. Dancing with the Whittier Stars will make its debut in May, 2012 at the Whittier Community Theatre. Designed as an event to bring all of Whittier together, ten "stars" from different segments of the community have been chosen to perform with a professional dancer.
